

Driving Directions to College of Menominee Nation, Keshena, WI



To Keshena – From North: Eagle River, Antigo, Rhinelander

If starting from Rhinelander, first take Hwy 8 East and turn south/right on Hwy 47/55. Take 45/47 south. At Antigo, the highway becomes 45/47/52. Proceed south on 45/47/52. Approximately 4 miles south of Antigo, Hwy 47 branches off to the east/left. Turn onto Hwy 47 and follow it to Keshena. Drive through Keshena and past the Casino. The College of Menominee Nation is located on the southern border of the Menominee Indian Reservation.

From Crandon: Take 47/55 south. Turn left when you reach Keshena. Continue through Keshena until you reach the College of Menominee Nation.

South: From Appleton, Madison, Milwaukee and Chicago (via Hwy 41) areas

Traveling north on Hwy 41, take the State Hwy 47 exit for north at Appleton. Proceed north on Hwy 47 thirty miles to Bonduel. At Bonduel, Hwy 47 joins State Hwy 29 and 55 north and west. Take Hwy 29 west. Proceed seven miles west on Hwy 29/47/55 to Shawano to the State Hwy 22 exit. Take the State Hwy 22 exit into downtown Shawano – turn right/north at the top of the ramp. Hwy 22 becomes Main Street. Follow Main Street to the intersection with Green Bay Street – about 2 miles. At this intersection, Main Street becomes Hwy 47/55 north to Keshena. Proceed north/straight on Hwy 47/55 for six miles to the College of Menominee Nation, located on the southern edge of the Menominee Indian Reservation

East: from Green Bay, Manitowoc, Sheboygan, Milwaukee and Chicago (via I-43) areas

From Green Bay take State Hwy 29 west toward Shawano approximately thirty miles. Take the State Hwy 22 exit into downtown Shawano – turn right at the top of the ramp. 22 becomes Main Street. Follow Main Street to the intersection with Green Bay Street – about 2 miles. At this intersection, Main Street becomes Hwy 47/55 north to Keshena. Proceed north/straight on Hwy 47/55 for six miles to the College of Menominee Nation, located on the southern edge of the Menominee Indian Reservation

West: from Wittenberg, Wausau, Eau Claire areas

Take State Hwy 29 east toward Shawano
On approaching Shawano, take the Hwy 22 exit (2nd exit from west) into downtown Shawano – turn left/north at the ramp stop sign. Hwy 22 becomes Main Street.
Follow Main Street to the intersection with Green bay Street – approximately 1.5 miles.
At this intersection, Main Street becomes State hwy 47/55 north to Keshena.
Proceed north/straight on Hwy 47/55 for six miles to the College of Menominee Nation, located on the southern edge of the Menominee Indian Reservation.
