College of Menominee Nation Student Checklist

Admission Requirements:

- ✓ Must be a U.S. Citizen or permanent resident.
- ✓ Must be a high school graduate/GED/HSED.
- ✓ CMN does not currently accept international students.
- ✓ Home school applicants will be considered on an individual basis.

Step 1. Apply Online

Visit our website at www.menominee.edu to submit your application. Click the 'Apply Here' tab on the upper right hand corner of the web page.

Step 2. Admission Documents

Admission documents required:

- Tribal enrollment verification (if applicable)
- High School transcripts and College transcripts

Submitting admission documents (choose one of the following methods):

- Upload documents to your MyEmpower account on the CMN website. (See Step 3 for more information)

Step 3. MyEmpower Account

MyEmpower is an online student portal used to monitor and track your Admissions and Financial Aid statuses.

You will receive your username and password when your admission application is submitted.
