Artist in Residence Program

The Library seeks to hire artisans who are willing to share their knowledge and expertise in traditional Menominee crafts as part of the new “Artist in Residence” program. The S. Verna Fowler Academic Library/Menominee Public Library received a grant from the Institute of Museum and Library Services to host "Artist In Residence" programming focusing on the revitalization of traditional Menominee crafts. Craft sessions would include instruction for adults with a more simplified version of the craft for children, and will result in a “How to” book and video for future reference.

Expectations:

- Provide a Native American- inspired craft, preferably Menominee style, for both an adult workshop and a corresponding children’s project that can be done within in a series of workshops.
- Work with a photographer on any narration for the How-to video that will be created with this project.
- Looking for four different artists to fill Summer 2019, Fall 2019, Winter 2020, Summer 2020 slots.
