This transfer agreement between the College of Menominee Nation and Central State University outlines a path for students to complete a Bachelor's of Science Degree in Agriculture at Central State University.

Students who complete an Associates of Arts and Sciences in Natural Resources at the College of Menominee Nation will have earned 48 Semester hours toward the requirements of the four-year agriculture bachelor's degree at Central State University.

Students may take courses online, in person, or hybrid.

Students who transfer to Central State University from the College of Menominee Nation must meet the following criteria in order to complete a Bachelor's degree at Central State University.

- 1. Complete all requirements for an Associates of Arts and Sciences in Natural Resources at the College of Menominee Nation
- 2. Meet all admissions and enrollment requirements of a student at Central State University.
- 3. Complete General Education Requirements for Central State University.
- 4. Complete all of the Major Requirements for the Bachelors of Science in Agricultural Education Extension.
- 5. Earn minimum of 120 Semester hours
- 6. Earn at least 24 Semester hours while enrolled at Central State University

In Addition to the transfer pathway agreement outlined above:

Central State University agrees to provide the following services to students:

- 1. Central State will send representation to The College of Menominec Nation minimum of two times per academic year for the purpose of:
 - a. Recruitment Central State University will meet with students during the Fall Semester Annually to review the opportunities for transfer, degree programs, scholarships, and student admissions processes and procedures.
 - b. Advising Central State University will send representation to The College of Menominee Nation during the spring semester annually for the purpose of advising students who have applied and been accepted to Central State University. Central State University representation will review student enrollment processes, provide instruction on registration in courses, review academic transcripts, and provide orientation for accessing Central State University systems including LMS, Email, and other IT systems relevant to student enrollment.
- 2. Central State University will provide financial assistance to students who complete the Associates degree program and choose to enroll at Central State University to pursue a B.S. degree in an approved degree program. The financial assistance will be provided in the form of Merit Scholarships to eligible students ranging from \$1000.00- \$4000.00 based on the prospective students GPA.

Students completing the requirements for an Associates degree will be eligible for tuition, Room, board and fees at the Out –Of – State Rate advertised by Central State University annually.

Students will be considered eligible (based on the eligibility requirements) of any Student scholarships available at the time of transfer.

- 3. Students enrolled at the College of Menominee Nation may also enroll in Central State Online courses. Students should follow the transfer pathway in this agreement to determine the benefits of starting courses at Central State University prior to completing the Associates Degree at the College of Menominee Nation. Students who enroll in Central State courses will pay tuition based on advertised tuition for Out Of State Students.
- 4. Central State University will provide transportation, room and board for Central State University during bi-annual visits.

The College of Menominee Nation agrees to provide the following services:

- 1. Office Space at the College of Menominee Nation for Central State University personnel to meet with students during the Bi-Annual visits.
- 2. Access to Internet connection to carry out University Business while visiting.

Renewal and review of this agreement:

This agreement will be reviewed and updated every three years from the signature date. If any changes are made to academic programs prior to the three - year review, all parties will be notified of those changes. The Director of the College of Menominee Nation and Central State University's Director of the School of Agricultural Education and Food Science will be responsible for the review and update of this agreement.
